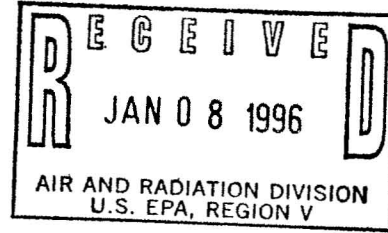

Dear Mr. Kee:

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources hereby requests delegation under section 112(l) of implementation of all existing NESHAPs and of our program mechanism for the delegation of all future standards under 112(d).

This program builds upon our approved Part 70 operation air permit program and relies on the authorities and resources cited already in our Part 70 program submittal. We understand that delegation under 112(l) is based upon the criteria outlined under 40 CFR 63.91. Our Part 70 program, approved by EPA, demonstrates how we comply with these criteria for part 70 sources. The focus of the enclosed materials will be the demonstration of how our program meets the criteria for non-Part 70 sources.

Similar to our Part 70 program, this program will cover all geographical areas of Wisconsin, except for activities conducted by Indians on reservation lands held by the eleven tribes.
