Dear Ms. Toney:

As required by 40 CFR 51.1203(a), the Georgia Environmental Protection Division is submitting a list of sources in Georgia that have annual actual SO₂ emissions of 2,000 tons per year (tpy) or more.

Annual emissions data was obtained from the annual reporting required by the Air Emissions Reporting Requirements (AERR) rule. Table 1 contains 2014 annual SO₂ emissions for all sources in Georgia with SO₂ emissions greater than 2,000 tpy in 2014.

There are ten (10) sources that exceeded the 2,000 ton per year (tpy) annual threshold in 2014. However, Georgia Power's Plant Kraft and Plant Branch have permanently shut down and Georgia Power's Plant Yates has permanently converted from coal to natural gas. The remaining seven (7) sources make up the list of sources in Georgia that are covered by EPA's Data Requirements Rule for the 2010 1-Hour SO₂ NAAQS. Georgia's source list includes:
