RE: Confirmation of Request to Remove Northshore Mining – Silver Bay from Data Requirements Rule List of Subject Sources

Dear Mr. Kaplan:

On June 8, 2016, I submitted to you a letter regarding removal of the Northshore Mining – Silver Bay facility (NSM) from Minnesota's list of sources subject to further air quality characterization requirements under the Data Requirements Rule (DRR) for the 2010 1-Hour Sulfur Dioxide (SO_2) National Ambient Air Quality Standard. The letter requested the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) removal of NSM from the DRR list pending completion of a state-enforceable Administrative Order by Consent (Order) limiting the facility's SO_2 emissions to less than or equal to 2,000 tons per year.

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency has executed the Order in question and therefore requests EPA finalize removal of NSM from the list of DRR-subject sources in Minnesota.
