The Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality (NDEQ) is submitting the following information in accordance with 40 CFR Part 51 Subpart BB "*Data Requirements for Characterizing Air Quality for the Primary SO₂ NAAQS.*" Subpart BB requires states that have sources with annual SO₂ emissions of 2,000 tons or more to submit a list to EPA by January 15, 2016.
