






SITE FUNCTIONALITY

STORMWATER IS DIRECTED TO BIO RETENTION CELLS, FILTERED, AND SENT THROUGH AN UNDERGROUND SYSTEM TO INFILTRATION GALLERIES WHERE IT **RECHARGES** BOSTON'S DEPLETED GROUNDWATER TABLE OR IS DIRECTED TO CISTERNS AND HELD TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION AND TURF COOLING ON SITE.
