Thanks. I have done an initial read-through and don't think there is anything we can't address, although some of the comments related to the BID/EIA need more scrutiny. I am going to try to create an overall listing (maybe a spreadsheet) of the sections/issues to help with consolidation. Some of these topics pop up in too many places, so that should help with the preamble.

In reviewing Section 12 in more detail, I have identified a couple of comments that I think belong in Section 1. They do not raise new issues, although the first one also makes claims about the effectiveness of the current work practices.

C. THE EPA SHOULD ISSUE NUMERICAL STANDARDS FOR RADIONUCLIDE EMISSIONS FROM URANIUM RECOVERY FACILITIES

The EPA should establish a numerical standard for radon emissions. Section 112(d)(2)(D) allows the EPA to establish a "design, equipment, work practice, or operational standard" under Section 112(h)(1) if it is "not feasible… to prescribe or enforce an emission standard."

When the EPA decides to issue work practice standards, Section 112(h)(4) requires that "any standard... shall be promulgated in terms of an emission standard whenever it is feasible to promulgate and enforce a standard in such terms." The hazardous air pollutant program under Section 112 is aimed at requiring numerical emission standards wherever possible. With respect to uranium recovery facilities, it is feasible to establish and enforce numerical emission standards (as evidenced by the current existence of numerical radon flux standards for "existing impoundments"). Therefore, the EPA should require uranium recovery facilities to monitor their emissions and meet numerical emission standards.

. . . .

Even if the EPA chooses to issue work practice standards for uranium recovery facilities, it should ensure that the work practice standards achieve the same or greater level of emissions reduction as a numerical emission standard would. Legislative history indicates that Congress intended the degree of protection achieved by work practice standards to be the same as the degree of protection achieved by numerical emission standards. Legislative History at 8,522-23. The work practice standards that the EPA is now proposing to adopt as GACT have resulted in emissions that were higher than what the numerical emission standard allowed. The EPA should not establish a work practice standard that allows higher emission levels than a numerical standard would permit.

(Comment 0155-35, see full document for supporting evidence)

Clearly, it is feasible to prescribe and enforce the radon emission standard in Section 61.252(a) [of CAA]. Clearly, the application of the measurement methodology is practicable and there are no technological and economic limitations related to the use of the measurement methodology used to determine compliance with the standard. For 25 years the EPA has relied on an emission standard for the control of radon from uranium mill tailings. EPA has not demonstrated that this method is unreliable, unfeasible, or has significant technical or economic limitations. Therefore, there is no legal basis for eliminating this standard for existing mill tailings impoundments and replacing it with a work practice standard. (Comment 0153-143)

Hi Phil,

I talked to Tom Gieck about the Maybell site and here is his answer to your question:

Maybell remained open for approximately 10 years from termination of processing until it was capped. I would not say that it just remained open to the elements for that period of time as there was a full time staff on site to perform O&M activities which, in the case of Maybell, consisted of continuously recirculating water from the evaporation pond to the top of the heap, i.e., heap essentially used to store contaminated process water as well as control any windblown material from the heap. Any erosional issues associated with the

heap were routinely repaired, site controls maintained, etc.

I have also chatted with Dave Holland from Hecla and checked the draft Durita CRR. Looks like a 2.5 ft random cover was placed after the operations ceased.

For Revision to National Emission Stands for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for radon emissions for operating mill tailings (40 CFR 61, subpart W):

- 1) EPA sent letters to approximately 50 tribes, in uranium producing areas, announcing the proposed rule, and requested the tribes to seek consultations with EPA. EPA held a tribal consultation with the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe in July 2014. There was significant communication between EPA and the Tribe prior to the consultation itself, and the communication with the Tribe continued throughout the comment period for the proposed rule.
- 2) EPA staff held public meetings that included tribal members or representatives in White Mesa, Utah; Gallup, New Mexico; Tuba City, Arizona; and Rapid City, South Dakota.
- 3) EPA also presented a national webinar for interested parties.

The National Tribal Caucus (NTC) is a national body of high-level tribal advisors. Members are selected on a regional basis by each Regional Tribal Operations Committee (RTOC) or its equivalent, and represent all tribes within their regions. Their primary focus is to identify and address tribal environmental issues that are national in scope, cross-agency or cross-media in nature, or that may be emerging or urgent.

The NTC is the body of tribal representatives, selected by their RTOCs, who meet monthly (via conference call) with AIEO and EPA Regional & Headquarters Tribal Program Coordinators. The NTC meets at least annually with the Administrator, AAs, and RAs to discuss policy environmental issues of importance to Indian country and Alaska Native Villages, with the intent to influence budget or policy decisions. This convening of the NTC and EPA senior political leadership is called the NTOC.

• Tribal partnership group representatives from the various media (air, water, waste, Exchange Network, toxics, and pesticides) have also been invited to participate and in most cases, co-lead these

discussions with NPMs as subject matter experts on their specific media areas.

- NTAA (Andy Bessler and Bill Thompson) will be participating in the discussion with OAR on June 7th. Bill Thompson also plans to participate in the other NPM discussions as well
- Other tribal partnership group representatives, aside from NTAA, are also welcome to join the OAR or any other NPM discussion.
- My understanding, from AIEO, is that the NTC and the partnership group representatives will be leading these discussions (see discussion questions) with EPA ready to provide updates and feedback.
- Getting the NTC interested/engaged in IAQ would be a positive step forward as the NTC provides
 input to senior EPA leadership (career & political) of environmental issues of importance to Indian
 country and Alaska Native Villages and would provide an opportunity to increase awareness among
 tribes, RTOCs, and also across the Agency at the senior level.
- To my knowledge, IAQ has not been mentioned at past NTOC meetings, but Pat Childers could confirm if it has been mentioned as an issues in the NPM NTC specific discussions
- Bill T may be key in relaying the importance of the IAQ Needs Assessment and encouraging the NTC to spread the word when it reopens for input
- It would be helpful to relay the spectrum of EPA's IAQ efforts (radon, asthma, guidance, training/webinars, other technical assistance) and also discuss the efforts to work more broadly across the federal government and with tribal governments to increase awareness of the connection between healthy homes in tribal communities and home construction, renovation, repair, and indoor practices. Discussing efforts to get agreement among other federal agencies to permit use of those specific funding sources to address or promote good IAQ practices.
- AIEO has asked the NTC to hold on discussions related to budget this year, due to the coming transition in Administrations; however there is always a possibility it may come up particularly in the area of resources available to address IAQ.

Greater funding opportunity for tribes to participate. Ozone impacts and effects in Indian Country

OAR recognizes the need for ongoing training and capacity building with our tribal partners. These opportunities are currently conveyed through our direct interactions with tribes and through the implementation of key grants, such as a cooperative agreement with Northern Arizona University's Institute for Tribal Environmental Professionals (ITEP) and ongoing efforts with the National Tribal Air Association (NTAA). The following are OAR's specific training and capacity building activities for 2016-2017:

What has been proposed for FY16 related to Ambient Air Quality and Toxics:

- **a.** Provide informational webinars and conference calls on program and regulatory development and implementation to allow tribes the opportunity to participate in the rulemaking process.
- **b.** Provide tribal designations support through training, technical tools and air quality analyses to allow tribes to participate in the designations process. [OAQPS]
- **c.** Expand the areas of training and general permitting to assist tribes with implementation of the Tribal New Source Review (NSR) rule. [OAQPS]
- **d.** Provide guidance and trainings for program development (i.e., Tribal Implementation Plan (TIP) Guidance and specific training on NSR). [OAQPS]
- e. TAMS Center Trainings: the TAMS Center will conduct 5-6 classroom courses annually including:
 - 1) GIS application in Air Quality.
 - 2) Air Pollution Technology.
 - 3) Management of Air Quality Grants.

Update on NESHAPS Subpart W rulemaking process,

- 2) EPA staff held public meetings that included tribal members or representatives in White Mesa, Utah; Gallup, New Mexico; Tuba City, Arizona; and Rapid City, South Dakota.
- 3) EPA also presented a national webinar for interested parties.

b) "Health and Environmental Protection Standards for Uranium and Thorium Mill Tailings," (40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 192 or 40 CFR 192). Informational webinars and presentations were made in 2015. A letter was sent to tribes in explaining the proposed rulemaking and inviting tribes to consult on the proposal. No requests to consult were received.

Staff presented on several National Tribal Air Association conference calls with numerous tribes in attendance. Presentations addressed 40 CFR 192, 40 CFR 61 subpart W, and 40 CFR 190.

For Health and Environmental Protection Standards for Uranium and Thorium Mill Tailings (40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 192 of 40 CFR 192):

- 1) Made informational webinars and presentations to explain the proposal.
- 2) Sent an invitation to tribes in January 2015 explaining the proposed rulemaking and inviting tribes to consult on the proposal. No requests to consult were received.

3) Held 4 public hearings. At the Chadron, NE hearing in May 2015, we had significant attendance by members of the Sioux Tribe. Four members of the Sioux Tribe testified, including a representative from the Oglala Sioux Natural Resource Regulatory Agency.

Invited federally recognized tribes to consult with the EPA on 40 CFR 192 and 40 CFR 61 Subpart W.

Response form EPA OAR to the NTAA's annual Status of Tribal Air Report:

Based on IED's ORIA Tribal Strategy, TAMS IAQ Implementation plan and other feedback from more advocacy for more IAQ Tribal training (i.e. NTAA's STAR report, etc.) EPA's Indoor Environments Division (IED) looks forward to more extensive collaboration with the TAMS leadership, and the TAMS Steering Committee and its members about how to appropriately and effectively expand TAMS' training audience, secure new markets and bolster more demand for IAQ training in FY15-16 and beyond.

In 2016-17, IED is banking on the deliberate collaborative relationships with Tribal IAQ advocates and stakeholders like TAMS, NTAA's-IAQ Workgroup, the Native American Indian Housing Council, and federal agencies like HUD's - Office of Native American Programs, HHS, USDA and others. These relationships will results in significantly more tribes applying for grants and funding opportunities — with "good" IAQ applications. It is with these deliberate activities more IAQ interventions will be achieved within Tribal communities.

Funding:

OAR administers over 12 million dollars in state and tribal assistance grants to provide for tribal governments and institutions to administer tribal air and related training programs. Tribes have continued to report out to OAR on the effect this lack of adequate funding has had on them. OAR was not immune to reductions either.

NTAA Executive Committee, TAMS Steering Committee and NTF – OAR's primary partners in implementing the tribal air program are the tribes themselves, the NTAA Executive Committee and TAMS Steering Committee. The NTAA and TAMS committees act as a conduit to the tribes and jointly sponsor the annual National Tribal Forum on Air Quality (NTF). OAR partnered with ITEP and the NTAA Executive Committee to support the NTF in 2015. In 2015-6, OAR continues to support development of tribal capacity to improve outdoor and indoor air quality and implement the Clean Air Act (CAA) in Indian country

Tribal Indoor Air Quality Programs - CAA 103/105 funding is inadequate; Tribes need a new, separate source of funding for IAQ work.

Briefly, there is significant competing interests related to the current suite of ambient air related program funding and how it's administered does not allow IAQ to always flourish – as it should. What has been done in the past, at this juncture, does not necessarily allow IAQ work and significant efforts to thrive; be distinguishable and sincerely be as successful. Thus, there is a growing philosophy that for IAQ risk reduction programmatic work and measurable efforts to be made...a separate source of funding would be best.

<u>Training for permitting for approval by tribes on minor source rules.</u>

What has been identified forthcoming related to the Tribal Minor New Source Review Rule-Final. Bundle #1 and Bundle #2

- a) Implementation of Tribal New Source Review Rules, includes:
 - Training, outreach, capacity building, planning and development for implementation by tribes and regional
 offices and meeting data and recordkeeping requirements,
 - Develop general permits and/or permits by rule and other rules to streamline implementation for 11 source
 categories: gas dispensing facilities; auto body repair and miscellaneous surface coating operations; petroleum
 dry cleaners; stone quarrying, crushing and screening facilities; hot mix asphalt plants; boilers; spark-ignition
 engines; compression-ignition engines; graphic arts and printing operations; concrete batch plants; sawmills.

Indoor air issues involving monitoring equipment.

IED is sincerely looking at design and adapt new courses with support from IED's existing guidance documents slated to improve single family housing, multi-family dwellings, and schools through our energy savings plus health building performance measures; and to help identify and equip trainers nationwide to teach these courses. This could include an expansion of available IAQ monitoring equipment to support the demand for more IAQ trainings.
