Dear Mr. Baker:

By letter dated December 15, 2016, Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) submitted to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency a request to change the characterization pathway under EPA's sulfur dioxide Data Requirements Rule (DRR) for the Pursue Energy Corporation Thomasville Gas Plant in Rankin County, Mississippi. Your letter sets out the rationale to change the DRR characterization pathway for the Thomasville Gas Plant from air quality modeling to a permanent shutdown and the EPA concurs with this rationale. Consistent with the requirements of the DRR, the appropriate documentation for sources permanently shutting down is due to EPA by January 13, 2017, and your letter indicates that MDEQ intends to meet this deadline.
