On September 11, 1979, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency delegated to the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) authority to implement and enforce certain national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants (NESHAPS) within the six-county area of RAPCA. According to the agraement, the delegation was scheduled for termination when the State of Ohio received delegated authority for NESHAPS.

Since the State of Ohio now has received a full delegation of the NESHAPS program on August 9, 1982, this letter is to be considered a termination notice of the September 11, 1979 delegation.

Although the agreement must be terminated, we will continue to depend upon your Agency in its new cooperative role with the State of Ohio as the HESHAPS program is administered Statewide. When needed, we will also depend upon your cooperation in supplying source information which was accumulated during the period the authority was transferred to RAPCA.
