To Whom It May Concern:

On January 6, 2017, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the California Air Resources Board (CARB) approved Parts A, B, and C of Settling Defendants' Emissions Modification for the 2.0 Liter Generation 3 Subject Vehicles within Test Group FVGAV02.0VAL covering Model Year 2015 Volkswagen Beetle, Beetle Convertible, Golf, Golf SportWagen, Jetta, Passat, and Audi A3 Diesel Vehicles. Today, EPA and CARB hereby approve Part D of Settling Defendants' Emissions Modification for these vehicles.

Defendants remain obligated to fulfill all other requirements set forth in Appendix B and any other applicable regulatory requirements. Any failure of terms, conditions, and regulatory requirements may be subject to stipulated penalties as specified in the Consent Decree.
