

# FINDING COMMON GROUND

UNIVERSITY COMMONS IS A 3.5 ACRE GREENSPACE ON THE UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI MEDICAL CAMPUS. THE PROPOSED GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE REDESIGN IMPROVES THE SITE'S STORMWATER MANAGEMENT CAPABILITIES, REDUCES ITS URBAN HEAT ISLAND EFFECT, AND OPENS UP THE SPACE TO COMMUNITY RESIDENTS AND EMPLOYEES WHILE EDUCATING THEM ABOUT GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE BENEFITS. THE NEW MULTI-FUNCTIONAL SPACE CAN SERVE AS AN EXAMPLE TO THE BROADER COMMUNITY, ENCOURAGING CINCINNATIANS TO EXPLORE AND IMPLEMENT GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE AT A BROADER SCALE.

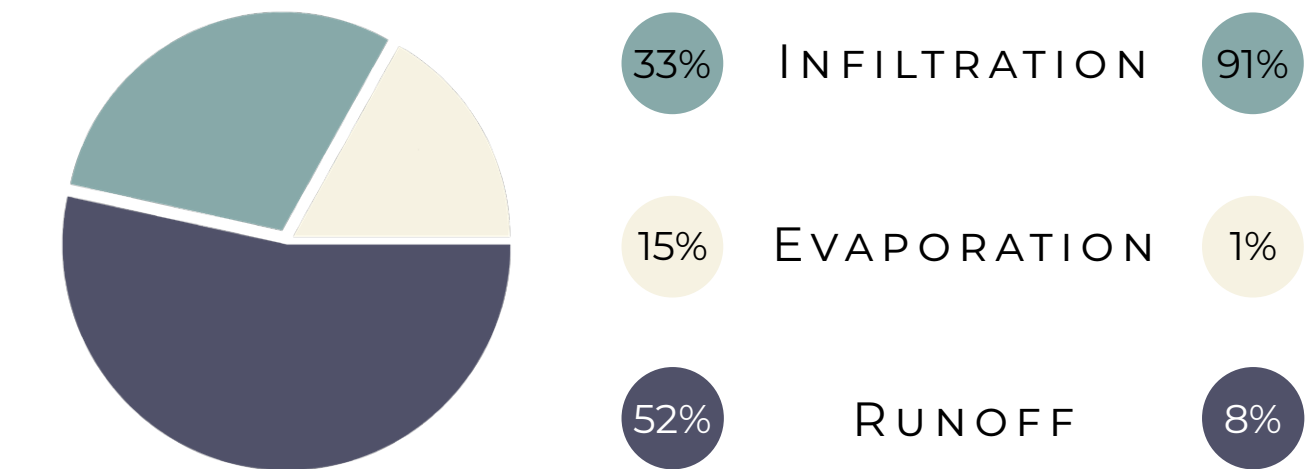
