Dear Mr. Spalding :

Your application for an air pollution control construction permit has been processed in accordance with s. 144.392, Stats.

The enclosed permit is issued to provide authorization for your source to construct and initially operate in accordance with the requirements and conditions set forth within Parts I and II of the permit. Please read it carefully. This permit expires 18 months after the day this permit is issued. The sources covered in this permit may not operate after this permit expires unless you have been issued an operating permit. Compliance information required to complete the operation permit for the sources included in this construction permit must be submitted at least 4 months prior to the permit expiration date.

Enclosed with the permit there is a bill for the cost of reviewing and acting upon your air pollution control permit. This bill is due and payable within 30 days of the date of the issuance of the permit. The remittance should be made payable to Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and returned to the address on the bill. Please return one copy of the bill with your payment.

A copy of this permit should be available at the source for inspection by any authorized representative of the Department. NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

If you believe that you have a right to challenge this decision, you should know that Wisconsin statutes establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed.

To request a contested case hearing pursuant to s. 144.403, Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for a contested case hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. Any such petition for hearing shall set forth specifically the issue sought to be reviewed, the interest of the petitioner, the reasons why a hearing is warranted and the relief desired.



For judicial review of a decision pursuant to ss. 227.52 and 227.53, Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file your petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such a petition for judicial review shall name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent.
