The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of *Annual Monitoring Report: Year 5 for Pleasant Ridge Compressor Station Restoration* (Monitoring Report), dated December 20, 2019. Restoration work at the Pleasant Ridge Site involved restoration work on 373 linear feet of SWV-AMK-001. The Monitoring Report indicates that this aquatic resource is self-sustaining and meeting the performance standards, and requests release from monitoring. Accordingly, EPA agrees pursuant to Appendix B, Paragraph II.b that the performance measures for restoration of the Pleasant Ridge Site have been achieved, no further monitoring is required, and the Site is released from further review.
