Dear Mr. Nichols:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 has determined that the W.J. Smith Wood Preserving Company site (the "Property") is Ready for Reuse. A Ready for Reuse Determination is an acknowledgement that environmental conditions on the Property are protective of human health and the environment based on its current and anticipated future use.

The Property was historically used to pressure treat railroad ties, utility poles, fence posts and other wood products with creosote and other special creosote solutions to preserve these products against decay. Pressure treating operations began in 1909 and ceased in 1991. Subsequently, the majority of the structures at the Property were decommissioned and removed between May 1991 and February 1992. This Ready for Reuse Determination is being issued for Parcels 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Property, depicted in Enclosure 1 to this letter. The parcels cover approximately 71.2, 8.3, 5.6, and 15.8 acres, respectively.

With this Ready for Reuse Determination, EPA Region 6 agrees that Katy Industries, Inc. has successfully conducted investigation, remediation and risk management activities, and that environmental conditions at the Property are protective of human health and the environment based on its current and anticipated future uses. Specifically, Parcel 1 is protective for residential use, whereas Parcels 2, 3, and 4 are protective for commercial/industrial use. The Ready for Reuse Basis of Decision (BOD) is provided as Enclosure 2 to this correspondence. Information concerning the current environmental conditions at the site and risk management activities to ensure protectiveness are summarized in Appendix F to the BOD. Copies of relevant documents are available in electronic format on the compact disk labeled as Attachment

I to the BOD, on file at the Grayson County Clerk's Office in the W. J. Smith Wood Preserving Company deed records.

If conditions on the Property change (e.g. land use is altered or new site receptors are identified) or additional impacted media are discovered, the current owner/operator will notify TCEQ and it may become necessary to perform additional investigation and/or remediation to ensure continued protectiveness. The undersigned expressly reserves all rights and authorities to require further action by owners or operators if new or additional information is discovered that impacts this Ready for Reuse Determination, whether such information is known as of this date or becomes available in the future.


