**Register for the next *Red Hill in Focus* webinar taking place Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>**

EPA and DOH are presenting our next webinar in the *Red Hill in Focus* webinar series **Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, from 5:00-6:30PM**. The topic of the upcoming webinar is the *2-Year Drinking Water Long-Term Monitoring Program*.

*EPA and DOH will discuss the 2-year Drinking Water Long-Term Monitoring (LTM) program. The drinking water monitoring of Joint Base Pearl Harbor - Hickam water system is intended to continuously ensure the drinking water meets all State and Federal drinking water standards and is free of JP-5. DOH will discuss the purpose of DW LTM and how the State tapwater action level for TPH, a complex mix of compounds that lacks a Federal drinking water standard, was developed. EPA will share information on federal standards and their technical assistance role. The Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command will also provide a demonstration of the [JBPHH Drinking Water System \(jbphh-safewaters.org\)](#) interactive map.*
