

### **BIL GOALS (2022-2026)**

Expand water quality restoration efforts and build regional resilience to climate change stressors in underserved communities.







#### **BIL-SFBWQIF** Project Types

- Green stormwater infrastructure in underserved communities
- Fish consumption outreach programs for subsistence or recreation fishing communities
- Watershed contamination investigations
- Community-led planning to help protect shoreline areas from sea level rise
- Wetlands restoration
- Trash control and cleanups

# **Outputs & Outcomes**

- Outputs = activities and/or deliverables
- **Outcomes** = environmental results, effects, or consequences
  - Outcomes must be quantified, and provide timeframe for expected results
  - Outcomes may be environmental, behavioral, health-related, or programmatic in nature, but must be quantitative.
- A description of how the project will track progress towards achieving outputs and outcomes is expected.





# Identifying Subawards and Contracts in Your Budget

#### **Subawards**

- Put in your budget in row "H" Other
- Typically, are funds that go to:
  - State and local gov't
  - nonprofit organizations for collaborative projects that further the missions of both organizations
  - colleges/universities and NGOs, state and local government

#### **Contracts**

- Put in your budget in row
   "F" Contractual
- Typically, are funds that go to:
  - for-profit firm or individual consultant
- Used to fund activities/services such as:
  - Project design, engineering, planning
  - Training or facilitation
  - Construction/project implementation

Applications (proposals) due June 29, 2023

**EPA conducts threshold eligibility review** 

EPA Review Committee will score and rank proposals

**EPA notifies applicants of funding status late-August 2023** 

Applicants submit full funding package to EPA September 2023

Grant awards expected November 2023
