Dear Mr. Deloney:

Pursuant to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) final rule approving Indiana's Section 112(I) Program of Delegation (62 FR 36460, July 8, 1997), EPA hereby grants the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) delegation of authority to implement and enforce the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants from Coal and Oil Fired Electric Utility Steam Generating Units, 40 CFR 63, Subpart UUUUU (Utility NESHAP).

On November 6, 2014, IDEM submitted a letter to EPA requesting delegation of authority of the Utility NESHAP. The requested delegation is a "straight delegation" and EPA finds that the following state rule has incorporated the corresponding federal NESHAP standard unchanged from the federal standard: 326 Indiana Administrative Code 20-89, effective October 19, 2014. IDEM has met the initial approval requirements as specified in 40 CFR 63.91(d) and has demonstrated adequate legal authority to implement and enforce the applicable federal standard.

Pursuant to Section 112(1)(7) of the Clean Air Act, nothing in this delegation prohibits EPA from enforcing any applicable emission standard or requirement.
