Regarding the secondary lead smelting NESHAP, in adopting this NESHAP, Indiana incorporated more stringent requirements that existed in the state lead smelting rule that is part of Indiana's lead state implementation plan (SIP). We submitted a request to Region V for a revision to the lead SIP for the lead smelting rule on February 2, 2002. John Summerhays is reviewing the SIP revision request.
