Pursuant to the May 1996 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), Region 5, the MDEQ requests an update to our April 28, 2004, delegation of authority to implement the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for certain subparts of *Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63*, listed below. This delegation of authority request is in addition to those already granted by the USEPA.

- Subpart OO, Tanks – Level 1
- Subpart PP, Containers
- Subpart JJJ, Group IV Polymers and Resins
- Subpart DDDD, Plywood and Composite Wood Products
- Subpart ZZZZ, Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines
- Subpart DDDDD, Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers and Process Heaters
- Subpart UUUUU, Coal- and Oil-Fired Electric Utility Steam-Generating Units

In addition, pursuant to the May 1996 MOA, the MDEQ requests delegation of authority to implement and enforce the NESHAP for the following subpart of *Title 40 of the CFR, Part 63*. This delegation of authority request is in addition to those already granted by the USEPA and is based on promulgation of the Michigan Air Pollution Control Rule listed below. A copy of the Air Pollution Control Rule is enclosed for your reference.

**R 336.1959 Emissions standards for glass manufacturing area sources.**

Rule 959. (1) The provisions of 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart SSSSSS, are adopted by reference in R 336.1902. The owner or operator of a facility subject to the provisions of "National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Glass Manufacturing Area Sources," 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart SSSSSS, shall comply with those provisions.

(2) For purposes of this rule, the terms "administrator" and "EPA" as used in 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart SSSSSS mean the department.
