  - A6: There is no requirement to provide copies of documents when reporting a suspected violation. Please provide all the information available to you.

  - A7: Ensure you are aware of all your responsibilities as a grantee by attending webinars, taking trainings, and reading all instructions provided to you.
- Q8: On large sites, where do you recommend posting the posters?
  - A8: We recommend locating posters near the other Federal required posters, such as required Occupational Safety and Health Administration or Equal Employment Opportunity posters.
