PROJECT

Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal
Permit No. 1070025-039-AV
Seminole Generating Station

The purpose of this permitting project is for the renewal of the existing Title V air operation permit and to incorporate the addition of the Seminole Combined-Cycle Facility (SCCF) and the switchyard emergency generator authorized by Air Construction Permit No. 1070025-028-AC (PSD-FL-443). This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 1070025-038-AV. This facility is an existing electrical generation facility that is owned by Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. The Seminole Generating Station (SGS) consists of one dry-bottom, wall-fired electric utility boiler and associated steam turbines; a coal storage yard; limestone, wet scrubber sludge and ash handling and storage; emergency equipment (emergency generator diesel engine, emergency fire pump diesel engine, fire water pump engine, and a switchyard emergency generator); general plant fugitive emissions; and ancillary support equipment.

NOTICE AND PUBLICATION

The Department distributed an Intent to Issue Air Permit package on June 6, 2024. The applicant published the Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit in the Palatka Daily News on June 15, 2024. The Department received the proof of publication on June 21, 2024. A proposed permit was issued for EPA review on August 27, 2024.

COMMENTS

No comments on the proposed permit were received from the EPA Region 4 Office.

CONCLUSION

The final action of the Department is to issue the permit with no changes.
