
**PETITION FOR REVIEW**

Pursuant to the Toxic Substances Control Act, 15 U.S.C. § 2618, the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 U.S.C. § §§ 701-706, and Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Appeal Procedure, the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America, AFL-CIO (“UAW”) hereby petitions this Court for review of the Final Rule of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA” or “the Agency”) entitled “Carbon Tetrachloride (CTC); Regulation Under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)” (“the Final Rule”).

EPA published the Final Rule in the Federal Register on December 18, 2024, at 89 Fed.Reg. 103512. EPA regulations provide that a final rule by the Administrator is “promulgated for purposes of judicial review fourteen days after

publication in the Federal Register.” 40 C.F.R. § 23.5(a). Accordingly, the Final Rule challenged in this Petition was promulgated for purposes of judicial review on January 1, 2025. 15 U.S.C. §§ 2605(i)(2), 2618(a). Pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 2618(a), jurisdiction is proper in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.


